

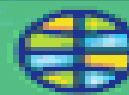

- GDP Official Exchange Rate (USD): 2013: \$124 Billion.

- Household Income Consumption by % Share: Lowest 10%: 6/10 of 1%. Highest 10%: 44.7%.
- Budget (2013): Revenue: \$52.75 Billion. Expenditures: \$48.48 Billion.
- Average Citizen Tax Rate: 42.5%

ECONOMY OF ANGOLA CONTINUED

- **Inflation Rate: 2012: 10.3%. 2013: 8.9%.**
- **Central Bank Discount Rate: Dec 31st, 2009: 30%. Dec 31st, 2010: Stopped.**
- **Commercial Bank Prime Lending Rate: Dec 31st, 2012: 16.81%. Dec 31st, 2013: 15%.**
- **Stock of Narrow Money: Dec 31st, 2012: \$13.31 Billion. Dec 31st, 2013: \$16.95 Billion.**
- **Stock of Broad Money: Dec 31st, 2012: \$40.34 Billion. Dec 31st, 2013: \$50.71 Billion.**

ECONOMY OF ANGOLA CONTINEUD

- Stock of Domestic Credit: Dec 31st, 2012: \$20.45 Billion.
- Exports: 2012: \$71.09 Billion. 2013: \$70.84 Billion.
- Export Products: Coffee, Cotton, Crude Oil, Diamonds, Fish, Refined Petroleum Products, Sex Slaves, Sisal & Timber.
- Major Export Partners (2012): China: 46.3%, India: 10.1%, South Africa: 4.2% & US: 13.9%. Others: 25.5% but individually less than 3% each.

ECONOMY OF ANGOLA

CONTINUED

- **Imports (USD): 2012: \$23.72 Billion. 2013: \$26.09 Billion.**
- **Import Products: Food, Machinery & Electrical Equipment, Medicines, Military Goods, Sex Slaves, Textiles & Vehicles Spare Parts.**
- **Major Import Partners (2012): Brazil 5.9%, China 20.9%, Portugal 19.5%, South Africa 7.1% & the US 7.7%. Others: 38.9%, but less than 5% individually.**

ECONOMY OF ANGOLA CONTINUED

- Reserves of Foreign Exchange & Gold (Converted to USD): Dec 31st, 2012: \$33.41 Billion. Dec 31st, 2013: \$37.94 Billion.
- External Debt to Foreign Countries (USD): Dec 31st, 2012: \$21.85 Billion. 2013: \$22.71 Billion.
- Stock of Direct Foreign Investments in Angola (USD): Dec 31st, 2011: \$12.15 Billion. Dec 31st, 2012: \$17.15 Billion.
- Stock of Direct Foreign Investments by Angola in other Countries (USD): Dec 31st, 2012: \$9.877 Billion. Dec 31st, 2013: \$12.87 Billion.

- Electricity Production (2010): 5.118 Billion kWh.
- Electricity Consumption (2010): 4.592 Billion kWh.
- Electricity Installed Generating Capacity (2010): 1.155 million kWh.
- Electricity from Fossil Fuels (2010): 56.9%.
- Electricity from Hydroelectric Plants (2010): 43.1%.
- Crude Oil Production (2012): 1.872 Million Barrels per Day.
- Crude Oil Exports (2010): 1.928 Barrels per Day.

- **Average Daily Internet Users (2009):** 606,700.
- **Airports (2013):** 176 (Paved Runways: 31. Unpaved Runways: 145).

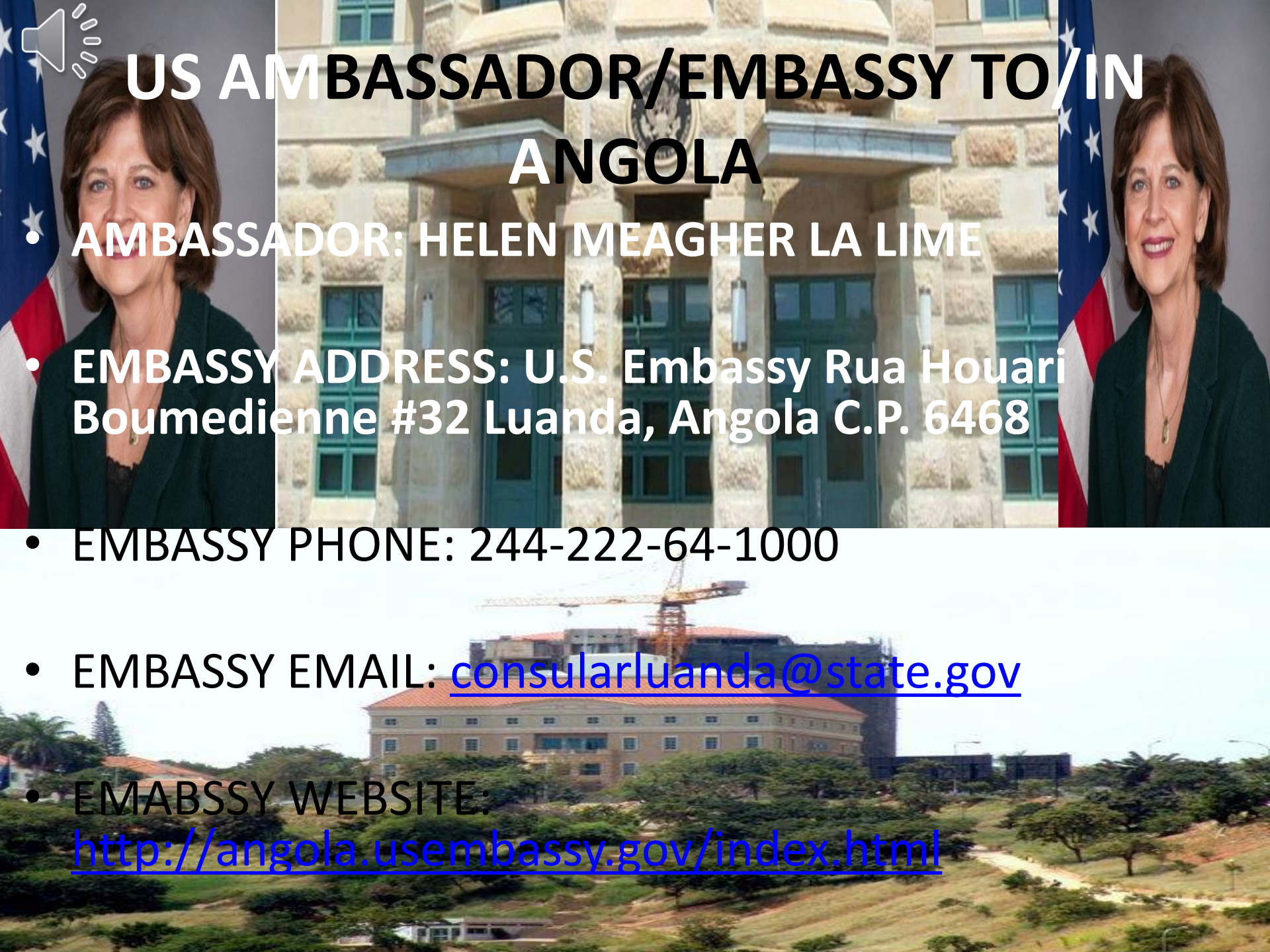
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- Heliports: 1
